

DO YOU WANT TO TRAIN TO BECOME A TEACHER?

Did you know that you can train to be a teacher at the North East Schools Teaching Alliance, which is based at Nunthorpe Academy, Guisborough Road, Middlesbrough, TS7 0LA?

The alliance, in partnership with the outstanding Northumbria University, offers School Direct Initial Teacher Training places for both Primary and Secondary teaching. Secondary places are available in English, Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Geography, History, Languages and Design & Technology.

The 10 month course leads to Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) and a PGCE. Trainees must have GCSEs in English and Maths, (and Science for Primary teaching), at Grade C or better. They must also have a degree at a minimum of a 2:2 and, for Secondary teaching, preferably in a subject related to that they want to teach. In addition trainees need to pass a Literacy and Numeracy Skills Test. Ideally applicants would have some classroom based experience which the alliance can help organise.

Bursaries are available depending on the subject and degree – for shortage subjects this can be up to £26,000. For further information
